The Parish Link

The *Parish Link* magazine is a not-for-profit print publication for Hanley Swan, Hanley Castle and the Wellands. There are 10 issues a year, including two double issues (July/August and December/January).

Content includes local news and stories, articles, events, reports, letters, history and issues, parish council information, people and business profiles, and other items of interest together with church services and advertising.

All editorial, design, distribution, advertising and finance functions are carried out by volunteers in Hanley Swan, Hanley Castle and the Wellands and are very much a local team effort.

When is it published?

Each issue is scheduled to be published at the end of the month. For example the May issue will normally be published at end April, the December/January double issue at end November.

How to subscribe

The 2023 subscription rate is £6 (or pro rata is you subscribe part way through the subscription year). This entitles you to 10 issues of the magazine, delivered directly to your door locally. To subscribe please contact email hanwelparishlink@gmail.com and we will organize one of our volunteers to take payment and deliver your copies.

In January your local volunteer deliverer will contact you and request subscription payment for the new subscription year, which begins with the February issue.

Can I buy copies separately?

Copies can be purchased at 70p per copy from the Hanley Swan village store or the Welland village store.

We will edit your contribution and check for sense, conciseness, spelling and punctuation, etc. There may be occasions we hold back non-time-sensitive contributions to a following issue, and inclusion in the magazine is at the discretion of the editor.

Photographs, maps or diagrams can enhance your contribution. Please seek permission from the copyright owner for us to reproduce any that are not your original work. Photographs should have a resolution of at least 1000 kB (1 MB).
